Your playtime

- Everyone's story of playtime is different
- If we asked each child in the class to tell us what they like best about playtime, they would have a variety of answers
- We're going to make a story about playtime – in pictures!



Let's start at the beginning

- Before we get our cameras out, let's get into groups
- Each group needs to create a storyboard of their playtime starting when the bell goes for playtime and ending when you return to the classroom
- Use Snapper's storyboard to help you
- On your storyboard write words in the boxes – or use stickmen drawings to tell your story



Tell your story

- Your storyboard should include putting your coat on, names of who you play with, what games you play
- You can also describe playing on the slide or playing hopscotch
- Don't forget to mention how you know when to come back to the classroom



Ready, steady, click!

- Once you are happy with how your story will flow, decide who will be first to take photographs to capture your story at playtime
- Everyone in the group should have a turn with the camera



Use different modes

- When you are taking photographs use different viewpoints and angles to get unusual shots
- Try sports mode to capture some moving shots
- If it's a sunny day, try sunset mode to give an orangy glow to your pictures



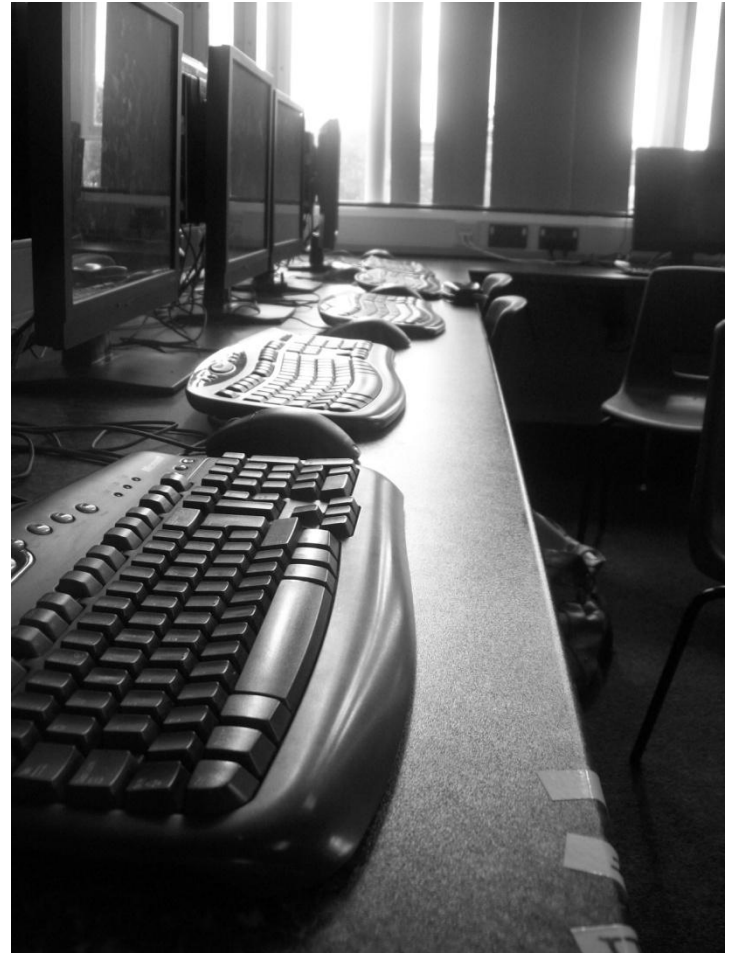
Be adventurous with the camera

- To give an unusual blurry image, try anti-shake mode
- Don't be afraid to try different modes – you might discover a whole new style!



Put it all together

- Collect all the images from your group work onto a memory stick
- Looking at them on the PC, choose the images that tell the story best and print out no more than six to tell your playtime story



Snapper's tasks

- Make a collage with your pictures and give the story a title
- As a group, present your story to the class using your photo collage as your centrepiece
- Make sure you have a beginning, a middle and an end to your story
- Happy snapping
