Filmmaking within R.E

Overview

Using clips from videos to actively involve students in identifying traditions within different religions. With emphasis on colour and the signifiers that's come with them. From this knowledge gathered, students can make their own informative videos about a specific religion to help educate others.

Learning Aims

- To learn the traditions of different religions
- To learn the signifiers different religions have for colours
- To write a script containing many facts and detailed information
- To produce their own informative video

Main Objective

Using videos of special occasions within different religions, students can identify the traditions practised and the uses of colour. They can then learn the signifiers of these colours in that specific religion. Once notes have been made, they can write up an informative and educational script, explaining the traditions and the history behind them. Also including facts and incorporating colour into the set or clothing. The format would be a simple presenter to camera set-up so there is no need for editing. The presenters should use their body language and gestures to better explain the script. These videos can be shown to the class to refresh their memories of the information included.

Optional Extras

Could add archive footage or still images to enhance the video if editing knowledge is present. Also any appropriate props could be used when filming.
