Breakdown of Sessions for the Applied Science Workshops:

- **Linguistics**

Learning opportunities include:

- Theoretical linguistics
- Applied Linguistics
- Forensic linguistics
- Phonetics – study of the physical properties of speech (or signed) production and perception
- Phonology – study of sounds (or signs) as discrete, abstract elements in the speaker's mind that distinguish meaning
- Applied linguistics – study of language-related issues applied in everyday life, notably language policies, planning, and education.
- Clinical linguistics
- Developmental linguistics
- Neurolinguistics – study of the structures in the human brain that underlie grammar and communication.
