- **Cognitive development**

(Cognitive development means how children; think, explore and figure things out. It is the development of; knowledge, skills and problem solving, which help children to think about and understand the world around them)

- Learning cycles, to be made from one subject into another
- Circa 15 – 20 activity themes, per learning cycle
- 3 stages of learning cycles (one level builds on the next)
- ‘Game master’ – parent in charge of asking questions to participants
- Time restraints – 2 minutes allowed, per activity to complete (egg timer)
